

On-line subscriber—Terms and conditions

By becoming an on-line subscriber, you request ICF to send you a regular email update through an automated email subscription system.

You give permission to ICF to store your personal details in an electronic database system. ICF will only store details necessary to send you a regular email update service.

Your information will be stored in a secure on-line database server. We will make every effort to maintain the security of the information, but cannot be held responsible for any breach of security or the consequence of any malicious attack on the data held.

ICF may from time to time send you additional information by email, this may include information about activities from other organisations. We will not share your details with any third party or organisation.

This is not a contractual arrangement, and there is no obligation on ICF to send information at any specified interval.

ICF will make every effort to ensure that all emails and attachments are virus free and contain no harmful codes or links. However it is the responsibility of the recipient to ensure that their computer is virus protected and ICF accept no responsibility for any harmful content that might become attached to their mails.

All regular emails will include an “unsubscribe” option which a recipient is free to activate at any time. It is the responsibility of the recipient to terminate subscription by this means, and while we will seek to cooperate with any reasonable requests, are not obliged to arrange to end subscription by any other means.

ICF will seek to ensure that the content of all their email bulletins is correct and up to date. However we cannot be held responsible for any false information that is communicated, or any actions undertaken by the recipient in response to these.
